# Sustainable Wearable Art Challenge



*Create a piece of wearable art showing your vision for a sustainable future.*

Entries are open to: teams or individuals

**Team:** This must consist of 1 child under 15 years old

**Individual:** Must be 16+ years

The challenge runs from:

Now – 2nd December 2020

Registration: You must complete the online registration form at [www.envirohub.org.nz](http://www.envirohub.org.nz), pay \$10 and then you will be contacted about a time to pick up your resource pack.

Entrants and general public will be invited to attend the Sustainable Art Challenge Awards ceremony on the 4th of December from 3:30pm - 6:30pm, to view the entries on the catwalk. You must supply a model for the runway show, this could be yourself or a friend.

All entries will be exhibited at the Remaker Space for 2 weeks after the runway show.

## Judging Criteria

- Innovation and Creativity – creative use of materials appropriate to the design concept.
- Stage impact – Eye catching- interesting design-good use of elements and principles of design.
- Wearable –fits the body, allows movement and holds together, no dangerous parts (construction).

Please note there is also a “Most Sustainable Award”.

Entries will be judged by a panel of local designers and artists and prizes awarded for each category.

## The Brief

Create a wearable art masterpiece from the pack of materials provided by the ReMaker Space and Envirohub. You MUST use at least 75% of this pack. You can also use “found” materials such as items that were otherwise considered trash or you bought from an op shop. The materials do not have to be soft materials, this can be anything you already own that could be transformed into wearable art. The only rule is that you can't buy ANY materials new.

All creations need to be dropped off at The ReMaker Space (at Our Place, Willow Street) by 3pm on Wednesday 2 December for pre-judging.

Prizes will be awarded for the most creative group and single entries, with top prizes for ingenuity.

## Things to consider

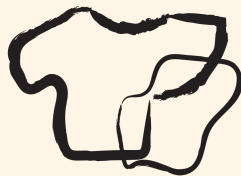
Think about the impact you are making with the materials you take, taking sea shells from the beach is removing a natural item from the environment which could have been a hermit crabs home. However, if you took a bottle cap from the beach you would be removing rubbish from the environment and therefore diverting it from landfill.

What are you going to use to hold your garment together with? Using new cable ties or large quantities of cellotape can be more harmful to the environment as you are creating more waste.

What message are you trying to display through your garment? Strong statements will be more favourably looked upon by the judges.

Is this wearable ART? Get creative, think outside the box and go wild with your creations. The wackier and more out there the better. This isn't a fashion competition, this is Art.

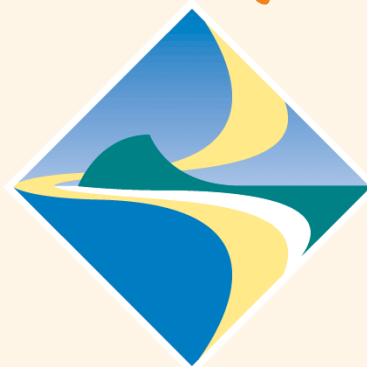
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
